- A) Annual Meeting Presentation
Finalized details for the MRS Annual Meeting presentation on May 6, 2021 @ 6:30 pm by Paul J. Chang, M.D., FSIM, Professor and Vice-Chairman, Radiology Informatics, University of Chicago School of Medicine. - B) Rockpointe Presentation
Committee agreed to accept an offer for a complimentary virtual lecture to the MRS membership on “Diagnosing and Assessing IPF: Role of the Radiologist”.
