



Who we are: Advanced Radiology Services is one of the largest physician-owned radiology practices in the country. What we do: ARS provides services to more than 60 different sites across the state of Michigan. We are the exclusive radiology provider to Spectrum Health's Betty Ford Breast Care Services. American College of Radiology has designated Betty Ford as a *Breast Imaging Center of Excellence*. We are accredited by the National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers. Only the top five percent of US breast centers have this NAPBC accreditation which means we can deliver the best care in diagnosing and treating breast cancer. We perform more than 95,000 breast imaging studies and diagnostic services annually.

What we are looking for: We are seeking a **Women's Imager** to join our team of clinical experts in Grand Rapids, Michigan. This team includes six breast surgeons. This is a full-time partnership track position and will provide services at Betty Ford Breast Care Services in Grand Rapids primarily with occasional rotations in Big Rapids, Greenville or Zeeland. Standard track physicians work 39 weeks and 11 weekends. The schedule would be days with a couple evening shifts per month. We could also consider a non-partnership track candidate (Full Time Associate Physician) which would require no nights or weekends.

Responsibilities:

- Interpret digital mammography, breast MRI, tomosynthesis and breast ultrasound
- Perform stereotactic, ultrasound-guided and MRI-guided biopsies

Requirements:

- Candidates must be proficient in all aspects of breast imaging including breast procedures
- OB ultrasound and general diagnostic radiology a plus
- American Board of Radiology or AOBR certified
- Completion of a breast imaging fellowship or equivalent experience
