



Who we are: Advanced Radiology Services is one of the largest physician-owned radiology practices in the country. Our growing practice includes 214 radiologists, 38 advanced practice providers, and 180 employees providing administrative support in our wholly owned subsidiary STARS. We value diversity on our team and promote a culture of inclusion.

What we do: We provide services to more than 60 different sites across the state of Michigan, including Spectrum Health, Bronson Health, McLaren Greater Lansing, McLaren Bay Region and Ascension Macomb-Oakland Hospital. Ascension Macomb-Oakland Hospital has two campuses- Warren and Madison Heights; the Warren campus is a full-service hospital with 24/7 emergency care, and a Level II Trauma Center.

What we are looking for: We are seeking a fellowship trained **Interventional Radiologist** to work in Warren and Madison Heights. This is one of 2 full time IR positions and will be a partnership track role. The schedule will be an alternate track status working 7 days on/7 days off for full compensation/benefits. Call will be compensated per our standard call pay procedure. You will also have the potential to pick up additional diagnostic shifts on a home work station if desired.

Responsibilities:

- This position is estimated to be greater than 90% interventional radiology.
- The IR practice covers a wide spectrum of inpatient and outpatient interventional procedures, including interventional oncology including Y-90, vertebral augmentation, ablations, trauma embolization, GIB embolization, biopsies, pain management procedures, diagnosis/treatment of vascular malformations, etc.

Requirements:

- American Board of Radiology or American Osteopathic Board of Radiology certified
- Completion of interventional radiology fellowship or equivalent experience

Why is our IR practice unique? ARS is a 100% physician owned and managed practice and fully committed to remaining independent. We are establishing a state wide IR service leveraging our DR (distributed radiology) platform. This allows us to interact with colleagues and provide expertise in all locations. We are working on establishing an outpatient clinic in Warren two half days per week to help build the practice. Additionally we have the support of two full time Advanced Practice Providers rounding and performing minor procedures at our two sites. We have quarterly peer review meetings to support physicians and promote continued learning. We now have an interventional radiology residency program in Grand Rapids which will allow our physicians opportunity for teaching (virtually) and research if desired.

Compensation/Benefits: We offer a competitive salary/bonus and opportunities for additional shifts to increase compensation. Our physicians pay nothing for medical/dental/vision coverage. We also contribute the maximum amount allowed to the 401K plan. We are continually striving to improve the work/life balance for our physicians.
