DISTRICT WINERY



District Winery is a boutique working winery set in the heart of The Yards, a bustling community in DC's Navy Yard along the Anacostia River. Winemaker Phil Arras produces premium small batch wines, combining the quality of tradition with the freedom of innovation. DC's first operational commercial winery offers wines made onsite. Co-founders Brian Leventhal and John Stires previously worked together in New York City and for several years made their own wine recreationally in New Jersey with a group of co-workers. After realizing how much fun winemaking is, Brian and John quit their jobs to open Brooklyn Winery in the vibrant and creative Williamsburg neighborhood. Now, the duo has brought their winery concept to a different but no less exciting city: Washington, DC.

Located a short walk from Nationals Park, District Winery is easy to get to by car, Metro, and bike.

Visit by Metro - Metro Train Take the Metro Green Line to the Navy Yard Station. District Winery is a short 5 minute walk from the Navy Yard Metro stop. Walk south on New Jersey Avenue SE. Take a left on Tingey Street SE. Take a right on 3rd Street SE. Take a left on Water Street SE. District Winery will be on the right hand side.

Parking - Parking is available directly east of District Winery at The Yards Lot Q, including game days at Nationals Park. Street parking is available but limited.
