Nearly half in MI House of Representatives (54/110) are serving for the first time Slimmest of margins: 56-54 split in House & 20-18 split in Senate

Expected legislative battles in 2023:

- > Address scope of practice expansion bills
- Improve/preserve physician reimbursement
- Reform pre-authorization/ Eliminate step therapy
- Protect against liability reform

> 2022 member contributions: \$38k

- 230 members contributed (<2% of membership)</p>
- ✤ Average individual contribution ~\$250/year

- ✤ Average individual donation ~\$500/year


