Budget & Finance – A. Finance Committee will review proposals prior to distribution to the Board for electronic vote.

Legislative Affairs – L. Davis; S. Kilanowski; R. Stallworth: Updates included nurse practitioner expansion, CME reform, and physician assistant scope. The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact expires March 28, 2026, with significant impact anticipated. The team will develop talking points, coordinate a letter-writing campaign, engage leadership offices and Rules Committee, and work with ACR to issue a call to action.
